NOTICE OF MIDTERM VACANCY

PURSUANT TO UCA 20A-1-510 PROVIDENCE CITY IS GIVING PUBLIC NOTICE
OF A COUNCIL SEAT VACANCY.

Providence City Council Member Trent Rasmussen will be vacating his council seat as of May 27, 2008. The Providence City Council will appoint a person to fill the vacancy during the Providence City Council Meeting to be held on May 27, 2008; the meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will be held at the Providence City Office Building, 15 South Main, Providence UT.

Persons interested in being appointed to fill the vacancy must meet the qualifications for office established in UCA 10-3-301:

- Residency Requirement: must have been a resident of Providence City (or an area annexed to Providence City) for at least 365 consecutive days immediately before the date of the election;
- Registered Voter Requirement: must be a registered voter in Providence City;
- Maintain Residency Requirement: must maintain residency within the boundaries of Providence City during the officer's term of office.
- Other requirements of UCA Section 20A-9-203:
 - In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section 20A-2-101.5.

Persons interested in being appointed to fill the vacancy may submit their name for consideration to Skarlet Bankhead, Providence City Administrator/Recorder on or before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 15, 2008.
