The Providence City Council will consider for adoption an ordinance changing the zone of approximately 44 acres of property, Parcel ID #s 02-114-005, 02-114-0030, and 02-114-0037, located generally north and east of 755 Canyon Road, from Agricultural (AGR) to Single Family Traditional (SFT); requested by Redstone Development LLC.

Item No. 1. Ordinance No. 003-2008. The Providence City Council will consider for adoption an ordinance amending Providence City Code Title 5 Chapter 1 Animal Control Regulations.

Item No. 2. Ordinance No. 004-2008. The Providence City Council will consider for adoption an ordinance amending Providence City Code Title 5 Police Regulations by adding Chapter 7 Lewdness, Profanity, Nudity, Obscenity, and Pornography; and Chapter 8 Unlawful Sexual Acts; and Title 3 Business License & Regulations by adding Sexually Oriented Business.

Item No. 2. Resolution 08-010. The Providence City Council will consider for adoption a

resolution awarding the bid for the 200 West water project.

Item No. 3. Discussion. The Providence City Council will discuss park and trail improvements in proposed Sagecrest Subdivision.
