ORDINANCE NO. 2021-011

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A SEWER COLLECTION IMPACT FEE PER PROVIDENCE CITYS WASTERWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, Providence City (the "City") is a political subdivision of the State of Utah, authorized and organized under applicable provisions of Utah law; and

WHEREAS, the City has legal authority, pursuant to Title 11, Chapter 36a of the Utah Code Annotated, as amended ("Impact Fees Act" or "Act"), to impose development impact fees as a condition of development approval, which impact fees are used to defray capital infrastructure costs attributable to new Development Activity; and

WHEREAS, the City does not currently charge an impact fee for Sewer Collection;

WHEREAS, wastewater treatment service for the City is provided by Logan City Corporation ("Logan City") pursuant to interlocal agreements dated June 19, 2017; collectively referred to as the "Logan City Agreements"; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement an impact fee for Sewer Collection services, referred to hereafter as "Sewer Collection Impact Fee" in accordance with applicable provisions of the Impact Fees Act in order to appropriately assign capital infrastructure costs to development in an equitable and proportionate manner as more particularly provided herein; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Sewer Collection Impact Fee is based upon the same ERU method as that used by Logan City for the treatment impact fee that has been established by Providence City, which the City Council hereby finds to be a reasonable plan that otherwise complies with the common law and the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Collection Impact Fee established by this ordinance is reasonable related to the cost of providing such public facilities necessitated by anticipated future growth within the City, said fee does not exceed the highest fee justified by the Impact Fee Analysis with a maximum collection impact fee amount of \$2,850/ERU.

WHEREAS, The Sewer Collection Impact fee will be consider separate from that of the Wastewater Treatment Impact Fee and is subject to termination at any time with no effect on the Treatment Impact Fee that has already been established per Cities Resolution 10-2020, and,

WHEREAS, the City has provided the required notice and public hearing requirements as established under the Act and related statutes; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the City Council on July 21st, 2021 to receive public input and comment regarding the proposed Sewer Collection Impact Fee.

WHEREAS, further information regarding the establishment of this impact fee can be found in Providence City's Wastewater Master Plan Section 6.0 User Rate and Impact Fee Analysis.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Providence City Council:

- Grants the execution of establishing a Sewer Collection Impact Fee that will adhere to the outline
 and recommendations of the Wastewater Master Plan referenced and set forth in Section 6.0 titled
 User Rate and Impact Fee Analysis.
- Will amend Providence City Code 9-1A-1 Reports Adopted to include Providence City's 2020
 Wastewater Collection System Master Plan Report: User Rate and Impact Fee Analysis.
- The Sewer Collection Impact Fee is to be set and used per its established eligibility for and on behalf of the future growth of Providence City.
