ORDINANCE NO. 06-2022

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A NEW CODE FOR PROVIDENCE CITY, UTAH; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF AMENDING SUCH CODE; AND PROVIDING WHEN SUCH CODE AND THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PROVIDENCE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, The Code entitled "Providence City Code," published by Municode, consisting of titles 1 through 11, each inclusive, is adopted.

WHEREAS, All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before March 16, 2022, and not included in the Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are repealed.

WHEREAS, The repeal provided for in the above statement hereof shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance that is repealed by this ordinance.

WHEREAS, Unless another penalty is expressly provided, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of the Code or any ordinance, rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall be guilty of a class B misdemeanor and punished by a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each act of violation and each day upon which any such violation shall continue or occur shall constitute a separate offense. The penalty provided by this section, unless another penalty is expressly provided, shall apply to the amendment of any Code section, whether or not such penalty is reenacted in the amendatory ordinance. In addition to the penalty prescribed above, Providence City may pursue other remedies such as abatement of nuisances, injunctive relief and revocation of licenses or permits.

WHEREAS, Additions or amendments to the Code when passed in such form as to indicate the intention to make the same a part of the Code shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code includes the additions and amendments.
